

Updating ONIX400 Map Software

Item you will need:

- Onix 400
- Computer
- USB Micro SD Card Adaptor
- Onix400 USB cable

Identify what Application Version you have:

(This information is in your ONIX400's SET menu, in the Unit Info screen. It is the "Application" number)

We are looking for one of the following APPLICATION #'s:

Instructions:

- To update the software you will need to put your files on the micro-SD card
- There are two methods to put these files on the Micro-SD card
- **Method 1:** using the Micro-SD card reader
- **Method 2:** using the USB Cable
- You can choose either method but, the files will transfer faster using the Micro-SD card (Method 1). If you do not have a reader, please use the USB cable (Method 2)

Updating ONIX400 Map Software

Method 1: Using Micro SD Card Reader Adaptor

Step 1

- Remove Battery
- Remove Micro SD Card
- Insert Card into Micro SD card reader
- Refer to **Step 1** from the files downloaded from the GPS website
- Drag and drop “**Step 1.ap**” onto the Micro-SD Card
- Safely remove Micro SD card from reader
 - To safely remove the GPS unit you will see located in the lower right hand corner of the screen a icon that when highlighted will say “**Safely Remove Hardware**” Once you click it, it will give you the option to “**Safely remove SD Device**”. You will need to select the correct drive in which you plugged in the Micro SD card reader
- Insert SD Card into Onix400
- Install the battery
- Power the GPS on
- Update will automatically begin
 - -This usually takes 1-2 minutes
- Unit will automatically power down once installation is complete

Step 2

- Remove Battery
- Remove Micro SD Card
- Insert Card into card reader
- Refer to **Step 2** from the files downloaded from the GPS website
- Drag and drop “**Step 2.ap**” onto the Micro-SD Card
- Drag and drop “**onixfs.bin**” into the *SYSTEM* folder on the Micro-SD Card
 - (This transfer may take up to 5 minutes)
- Safely remove Micro SD card from reader
- Insert Micro SD Card into Onix 400
- Install the Battery
- Power the GPS on
- Update will automatically begin
 - This usually takes 7-10 minutes
- Unit will automatically power down once installation is complete

Updating ONIX400 Map Software

Method 2: Using the Onix400 USB Cable

Step 1

- Securely plug Onix400 into USB on your Computer
- Go to “My Computer” to find this as a **Removable Drive**:
- Refer to **Step 1** from the files downloaded from the GPS website
- Drag and drop “**Step 1.ap**” onto the Onix400 Removable Disk:
- Safely remove Onix400 Removable Disk card from the computer
 - To safely remove the GPS unit you will see located in the lower right hand corner of the screen an icon that when highlighted will say “**Safely Remove Hardware**” Once you click it, it will give you the option to “**Safely remove Device**”. You will need to select the correct drive in which you plugged the Onix400 in
- Power the GPS on
- Update will automatically begin
 - -This usually takes 1-2 minutes
- Unit will automatically power down once installation is complete

Step 2

- Securely plug Onix400 into USB on your Computer
- Refer to **Step 2** from the files downloaded on GPS website
- Drag and drop “**Step 2.ap**” onto the Onix400 Removable Disk:
- Drag and drop “**onixfs.bin**” into the SYSTEM folder on the Onix400 Removable Disk:
 - (This transfer may take up to 30 minutes)
- Safely remove Onix400 Removable Disk from the computer
- Power the GPS on
- Update will automatically begin
 - -This usually takes 7-10 minutes
- Unit will automatically power down once installation is complete

Checking you Application Version:

Step 1

- After installing the Update successfully we need to make sure the update has worked.
- On the Onix400 please press the **Menu** button
- Then select the **Set** icon in the right corner
- Then scroll all the way to the bottom go to **Unit Info**
- Now we are looking for the **Application: 3.02606.4198**
